JUSTICE FOR IMMIGRANTS



Our parish will be participating in the USCCB Justice for Immigrants Postcard Campaign during the weekend of April 24-25. To better understand the issues surrounding immigration, information can be found on the Justice for Immigrants' table in the church Commons. Some of the topics covered are: Comprehensive Immigration Reform, Immigration Myths, Immigration and the Economy, and a list of immigration legislative bills for the 111th Congress. Pope Benedict XVI called on the political leaders to assist "migrants and their families with the help of specific legislative, juridical and administrative protection." Let us be part of this effort.

CREATION CARE GROUP

God called us to "fill the earth" and to "have dominion over" it as "stewards" of God himself. As God's co-worker, man has a duty to exercise responsible stewardship over creation, to care for it and to cultivate it. Natural resources should be used in such a way that immediate benefits do not have a negative impact on living creatures; present and future. As Pope Benedict XVI states in his 2010 World Day of Peace message, "The Church has a responsibility towards creation, and she considers it her duty to exercise that responsibility in public life, in order to protect earth, water and air as gifts of God the Creator meant for everyone."
