Sacrament of Baptism

Once a month during weekend Liturgy. Pre-baptismal session for both parents is required.

Sacrament of Penance

Saturday at 4:00 PM. At other times, contact priest for appointment.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Celebrated during Easter Season. Individuals must have been in religious formation for at least one year. Immediate preparation begins in 10th & continues in the 11th grade. For adult confirmation preparation, contact parish office.

Sacrament of Marriage

Requires at least six months advance notice before Marriage date is set. Preparation process for engaged couples is required. Contact parish office for dates of prep sessions and call immediately the priest or deacon who will witness your vows.

Pastoral Care

Pastoral Care ministers support our priests in bringing Eucharist to homebound parishioners, those in hospitals, nursing homes, and assisted living facilities. Call the Parish Office at 774-0066 if a hospitalized or homebound family member or friend would like to receive Eucharist and/or the Sacrament of the Sick.

Question of the Week

John 13: 31-33a, 34-35

The commandment to "love one another" can seem trite. This means that we seem to hear it all the time, so much so that it becomes meaningless. Love, love, love! However, we can look for other ways to say this. Perhaps then we will understand it better. For example, a TV show popular some years ago had this line: "Take care of each other out there!" Taking care of others is a way of loving. This is part of what Jesus meant. Can you think of other words that say "love one another" or express what love is?
