Sacrament of Baptism

Sacrament of Penance

Saturday at 4:00 PM. At other times, contact priest for appointment.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Celebrated during Easter Season, Individuals must have been in religious formation for at least one year. Immediate preparation begins in 10th & continues in the 11th grade. For adult confirmation preparation, contact parish office.

Sacrament of Marriage

Requires at least six months advance notice before Marriage date is set. Preparation process for engaged couples is required. Contact parish office for dates of prep sessions and call immediately the priest or deacon who will witness your vows.

Pastoral Care

Pastoral Care ministers support our priests in bringing Eucharist to homebound parishioners, those in hospitals, nursing homes, and assisted living facilities. Call the Parish Office at 774-0066 if a hospitalized or homebound family member or friend would like to receive Eucharist and/or the Sacrament of the Sick.

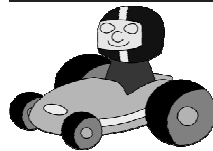
* ADULT CHRISTIAN FORMATION
