## **SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM**

Once a month during weekend Liturgy. Pre-baptismal session for both parents is required.

## **SACRAMENT OF PENANCE**

Saturday at 4:00 PM. At other times, contact priest for appointment.

## **SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION**

Celebrated in the Easter Season, candidates must be enrolled in religious education and attending mass regularly in order to begin Confirmation preparation. Youth Confirmation takes place in the 10th grade or later. For adult Confirmation preparation, contact the parish office.

## **SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE**

Requires at least six months advance notice before Marriage date is set. Preparation process for engaged couples is required. Contact parish office for dates of prep sessions and call immediately the priest or deacon who will witness your vows.

## **PASTORAL CARE**

Pastoral Care ministers support our priests in bringing Eucharist to home-bound parishioners, those in hospitals, nursing homes, and assisted living facilities. Call the Parish Office at 774-0066 if a hospitalized or home-bound family member or friend would like to receive Eucharist and/or the Sacrament of the Sick.

#### **Liturgy**

Liturgy is a time when we allow ourselves to feel Christ's presence through the Eucharist, the sacraments, the proclamation of the Word of God, in the ministers of the liturgy and in the assembly gathered for prayer and praise. The People of Nazareth are encouraged to **actively participate** in the different liturgical ministries mentioned below:

#### **Eucharistic Ministers**

You will offer the Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus at Communion time during the Liturgy. Formation required. Must be confirmed. Commitment: 4 hours per month assigned.

#### **Ministers of Hospitality/Greeters**

Warmly greet and guide people at liturgy, helping with seating, the collection, and Presentation of the Gifts procession. Open to all ages. Commitment: 4 hours per month.

#### **Sacristans**

Take care of vestments, linens, and vessels used for Liturgy. Open to youth and adults. Commitment: 4-6 hours month

#### **Servers**

Boys and girls in Grade 5 and up who assist the priest during the liturgies. Commitment: 2-3 hours per month.

#### **Art & Environment**

Artists of all Mediums and manpower to execute design are needed in decorating the worship environments. Commitment: 2-3 hours per meeting.

#### **Music Ministry**

Joyously proclaim the Word of God in song by either singing or playing an instrument at Liturgy. There are three choirs available: Children (ages 7-11), Youth (ages 12-17), and Adult (any age over 17). Commitment: weekly rehearsal schedule and liturgy.
