LET THE CHILDREN COME!!

Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me; do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs." If you are the parent of an unbaptized child, or a child who is baptized but who has not been involved in regular religious formation, you are invited to bring your children into the Children's Catechumenate.

The process involves forming children in the faith of the church and celebrating their conversion through the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. Children who enter the Catechumenate must be at least 6 years of age and may be sons or daughters of adult catechumens or children of Catholics who have left the church and are now returning. After he was well, he embarked on pilgrimages, took retreats, and studied theology in Barcelona and Paris. He founded the Society of Jesus in 1534. Today, the Jesuits have over thirty thousand members. His feast day is July 31.
