## Sacrament of Baptism

Once a month during weekend Liturgy. Pre-baptismal session for both parents is required.

## Sacrament of Penance

Saturday at 4:00 PM. At other times, contact priest for appointment.

## Sacrament of Confirmation

Celebrated in the Easter Season, candidates must be enrolled in religious education and attending mass regularly in order to begin Confirmation preparation. Youth Confirmation takes place in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade or later. For adult Confirmation preparation, contact the parish office.

## Sacrament of Marriage

Requires at least six months advance notice before Marriage date is set. Preparation process for engaged couples is required. Contact parish office for dates of prep sessions and call immediately the priest or deacon who will witness your vows.

## Pastoral Care

Pastoral Care ministers support our priests in bringing Eucharist to homebound parishioners, those in hospitals, nursing homes, and assisted living facilities. Call the Parish Office at 774-0066 if a hospitalized or homebound family member or friend would like to receive Eucharist and/or the Sacrament of the Sick.

**\* SAN DAMIANO CROSS REFLECTION**

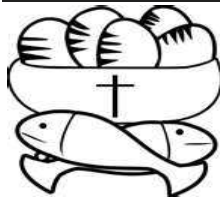

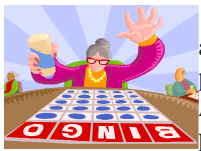
**ICE CREAM SOCIAL**

**OLN PARISH COUNCIL**

The parish council has been preparing the "We Walk By Faith" report for the Bishop that is due prior to his visit to our parish on October 31st. The document is a compilation of information gathered from several previous parish councils as well as the current one describing OLN in the areas of Word, Worship, Community and Service. Findings from the parish council subcommittee, as well as the strengths and needs of our community and the general comments made by our parishioners on the parish survey were integrated into a Power Point presentation. Recently, the parish council met with finance council and parish staff to give them the opportunity to have input to this presentation prior to it being shared with the parish at the next town hall meeting. Following your input at the town hall meeting to be scheduled sometime in September, the necessary revisions will be made prior to sending the completed document to the Bishop. From this work we are also generating a one-year and five-year plan for our parish. Please watch the bulletin for the date of the next town hall.
