## John Mary Vianney

Priest

The suppression of the Church during the French Revolution (1789-1799) resulted in an unchurched and ignorant generation. Jean Mary Vianney desired to draw these lost souls back to the Church and re-educate them in their faith. As the *curé* (parish priest) of the isolated village of Ars, he began by living a life of austerity and mortification, and brought catechesis and the sacraments, especially the sacrament of Reconciliation, back to the people. His reputation for holiness spread throughout France; so many wished to see the *Curé de Ars*, that one could wait over a week to see him. Already the patron saint of diocesan priests, Pope Benedict has announced that he will declare St. John Vianney the patron of *all* priests during the Year of the Priest. His feast day is this week, August 4.

*The Center for Disease Control is issuing warnings that since the Swine Flu has already affected 40,000 in the U.S and more world wide (Pandemic) even before Flu season. We are in for a rough Fall. By the end of September 60,000 deaths are expected. Therefore, several Pharmaceutical companies have prepared vaccines which will be administered "en mass" at schools, clinics, pharmacies, etc. at little or no cost.
