Question of the Week
Mark 10: 46-52

Bartimaeus “throws aside” his cloak—a symbol of his beggar’s cloak, a symbol of his immobility as a blind man—and jumps up and “comes” to Jesus. What immobilizes my faith? What do I need to throw aside in order to come closer to Jesus?

Family Question: When Bartimaeus was blind his faith was immobilized (unable to act). Jesus calls him and heals him and his faith flies into action! What is it about our world that immobilizes our faith? What is it about Jesus that makes us want to be like him?
