2) The Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) collection is scheduled for the weekend of November 22/23. CCHD is the U.S. Bishop's domestic anti-poverty program. Unlike a number of other anti-poverty programs, CCHD funds low-income self-help efforts to root out poverty by empowering individuals to develop innovative programs addressing the causes of poverty. In addition, 25% of the collection totals will remain in our own Richmond Diocese. Incidentally, in the recent past OLN parishioners have served on the CCHD Diocesan boards that determine the state grants. Please be generous.
